OUR POST SSR ACTIVITIES SINCE JUNE 2016 TO NOVEMBER 2017

Summary:

Criterion 1:

Maintaining our Vision and Mission statements, we carry on our efforts to develop a multi-dimensional personality, maximum stakeholder participation, preparing Academic Calendar in tune with institutional objectives and organizing Extensive and Extra co-curricular activities.

Stakeholder participation continues to be ensured through periodic meetings, advertising through Prospectus, College Website and through other informal measures.

Stakeholder feedback is thoroughly ensured now through feedback forms sent and filled on line by past and present students, forms filled in classrooms by present students - that include feedback on institution and also feedback forms for faculties. Data collected is analyzed for further necessary action.

Faculty development programme has been organized wherein the entire staff of the college has begun training in various computer related programmes such as MS Office.

An MOU has been signed with Raksh Infotech to start computer programs for students.

It was sensed that apart from skills in Commerce imparted to students, a little more needed to be done for girl students. Considering most of them would not be pursuing jobs but would remain responsible house makers, the need to introduce some means of skill oriented courses arose. This would help them earn some extra income for their family, financially support their family, and also be economically self reliant. This has prompted the foresighted management and the I/C Principal to introduce two new Vocational Courses as a means of empowering women.

- (1) Nursing (MOU with Lakshya Institute)
- (2) Fashion Designing (MOU with Lakshya Institute)

Over and above this, special guest lectures to empower girl students have also been organized by Planning Forum and Women's Empowerment Cell.

Focusing on attempts to address cross cutting issues of Environment, strengthening the Female sex, awareness for human rights, cyber safety and concerns of safety and holistic development, we have organized various activities such as Tree plantation drive under NSS, Creating awareness about Cleanliness by celebrating Swachhata Day by NSS, celebrating Khadi Day to promote small scale industries by NSS, organizing lectures specially for female students on health issues and female sex empowerment by Planning forum and Women's Empowerment Cell, lectures by eminent resource persons on Cyber safety awareness & crimes, Digital marketing, Workshop on GST, celebrating no pollution day by using no vehicles for one day, and holistic activities as Happiness Seminars for NSS students and conducting Happiness Programs under the Art of Living wing at the institute.

SCOPE has been re-registered and classes for them shall soon commence.

A program for world peace and welfare with traditional Vedic chants of mantras was held with NSS volunteers offering SEVA.

On taking serious note of popular student request to start a fire safety training program at the institute, we have begun putting

efforts in the direction. Our efforts may soon be transformed into effective action with the course beginning before end of this term.

Criterion 2:

Faculties have now started using OHP and Tablets inside classrooms. The construction of a Multi-media hall and Computer Lab is complete. The Multi media hall is used for hosting Cultural events, Seminars, Lectures and for Yoga and Holistic activities. Faculties have gained computer literacy that has helped them towards more effective performance and lesser dependence on Non teaching staff.

Criterion 3:

Our Research potential has now seen a huge rise with 04 faculties at present having Ph.D Degrees and 11 Faculties with M.Phil Degree. We now have a computer lab functioning with 40 computers having Net connectivity.

The Management organized a One Day National Level Faculty Development Program, the very first of its kind, based on

Digital Research tools and Gear for Researchers . All staff and faculties from all over India were invited. A lecture on Digital Marketing has also been organized.

Criterion 4:

Infra-structure facilities have been upgraded and the latest changes have increased stakeholder satisfaction in terms of enabling opportunities for maximum output and learning.

Criterion 5:

The enviable Teacher-Student rapport continues. The Alumni Association and Parents' Association have been formed and frequent meetings are held. Feedback is taken and the suggestions are taken up for necessary action. Frequent meetings have led to a better rapport and more contribution from Alumni towards the institution in terms of academic aid to economically weak students. The institute has started moving towards a larger vision of stakeholder participation and progress.

Student progress is encouraged with further motivation by introducing more prizes for brilliant Academic Performance. From the year 2016-2017, the IQAC has started awarding cash prizes to first two ranking students of all semesters at their Internal examinations. 42 Cash prizes were given during the Prize Distribution ceremony held on 17/02/2017

Criterion 6:

The Management, IQAC and the important Committees have relentlessly endeavored to ensure Quality Initiatives, maintenance and sustenance. New measures have been introduced to assure quality parameters are maintained throughout. Placement activities have been focused upon and faculties have begun working actively in that direction. We have undertaken Green Audit of the institute.

Criterion 7:

Our Best Practices as Extension activities under NSS, Cultural and Co-curricular as well as other activities for Holistic development continue to nurture values of a high moral order among our students.

SWOC:

Focusing on the SWOC analysis of the Institute, we proudly maintain a hike in infra-structure, thus increasing student resources availability. Classrooms have been dressed with good quality curtains, OHPs, Tablets and waste paper baskets. Where previous faculties have left, adhoc staff has been appointed.

Previous less research aspect has been effectively overcome with increased Research activity. We are proud witness to one

of our faculties, Dr. Roshan S. Patel who has contributed to the academic world with publishing three new books.

The institute has witnessed quite a few positive changes in the whole scenario of Teaching-Learning aspects, Research and Infrastructure facilities.
