The NSS unit of the college celebrated Kargil Vijay Diwas on 26th July 2024. A large number of NSS students and program officers participated in this patriotic event.








$27^{th}\ July\ 2024-Orientation\ Program$








27th July 2024 - Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's Death Anniversary




05th December 2024 – HIV/AIDS Awareness Seminar








13th December 2024 – Youth Voter Festival

The national flag was hoisted by Principal Dr. Heena S. Oza.


All teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and NSS volunteers were present and enthusiastically participated in the celebrations.
